- Your help is needed. Please sign up on the volunteer sheet this morning located in the Welcome Center.



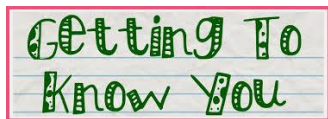

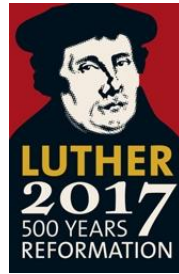
