- Your help is needed. Please sign up on the volunteer sheet located in the Welcome Center on the table next to the robot.

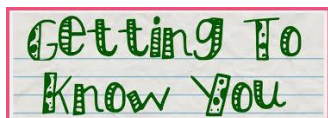


Today's altar flowers are given to the glory of God and are presented by Phil and Nancy Becker in honor of their wedding anniversary (June 17). Congratulations!
