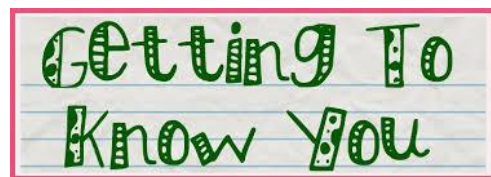

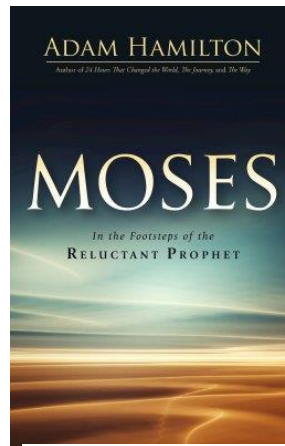
Fall - Harvest Festival & Silent Auction November 12
