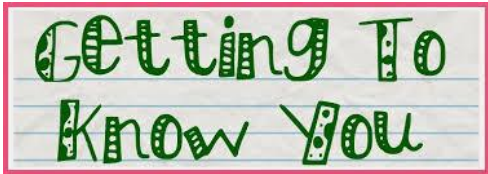

Week 2: Hope

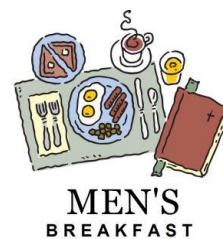
Week 3: Anger
