contact the church office at 614-866-4386. It would be used primarily for hauling and for putting salt on the parking lot in the winter when it snows, or when it's icy.

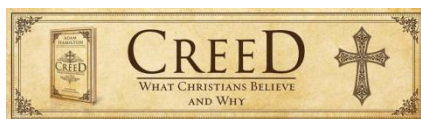


Winter is on its Way!
