Bakers needed for our wonderful **Christmas Cookies** to sell on Dec. 10. Please sign up to bake 10-11 dozen (Often can be done as a double batch) of your **favorite colorful traditional cookies**. Here is the

process:

Bake your special cookies, **store** carefully in a **disposable container** and freeze if you want to get them done early.

Mark your name clearly on the top of the container.

Bring them to one of the back tables in Fellowship Hall 1-4 pm on Friday, Dec. 8 or Saturday morning, Dec. 9 between 9 & noon. **Boxing** - A nice assortment of cookies will be packed in boxes on Saturday afternoon - noon **until probably 2:30**. **Selling** - will occur on **Sunday morning at 9:00 until sold out**. **Medium size boxes are \$12 and large boxes \$20**. Check any grocery store or bakery to know that this is a bargain for holiday cookies.

Bakers should fill out a green slip and put it in the cookie basket on the table in the narthex. Folks who would like to help box on Sat. or sell on Sunday morning should sign the sheets found there. **New members** - this is a fun traditional project at Messiah - **Bring your cookies and stay to pack or plan to be at the sales table on Sunday morning** It is a fun way to meet new people.

Anyone who absolutely can't bake is encouraged to write Cookies on a plain envelope with your name, put your cash donation inside (or check to Joseph's Coat) and place in the offering plate.
