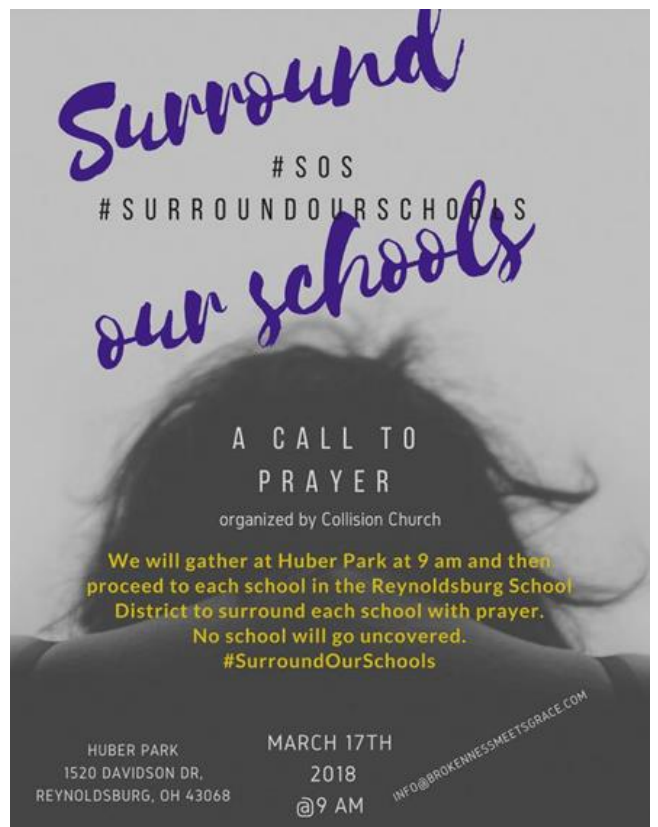


An informational meeting will be held at Messiah Lutheran Church on **Monday, March 26 at 6:30pm in the Fritz Hall.**
