Memorial Garden Pavers – This is the last day to order pavers. Marge Seymour and Pat Speakman will be in the Welcome Center after all three services today.

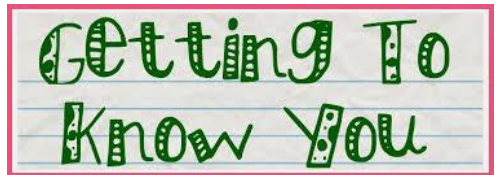
