Messiah's First Free Produce Market - June 12

Volunteer at Messiah's Free Produce Market Tuesday, June 12. This Sunday, June 10th, a table is in the Welcome Center Sunday to sign up to serve to help our neighbors in need.

The Mid-Ohio truck arrives between 1:00 and 2:00 PM. The most help is needed from 1:00 to about 3:00 to sort and bag fruit and veggies and set up table displays. We ask any youth (with your parent's permission) 10 and over to volunteer to take groceries to the neighbor's cars between 3 and 6 and return them to the picnic shelter.

Please plan to come when you can and leave when you must. We need help every hour; and are still looking for someone to set up the refreshments in the kitchen and prepare the water coolers for the fellowship hall and portico.

There will be two additional events this summer on the second Tuesday of July and August. Our final event is the Saturday before Thanksgiving, so Messiah's working families can assist with the distribution.
