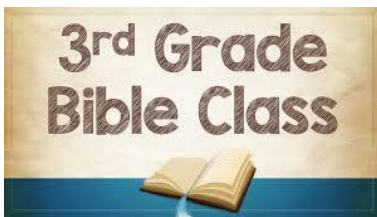


### A special invitation
