confirmed on May 19). Please keep these confirmands in your prayers.


Capital Campaign Update

We have great news to share. To date we have received \$170,000 of the almost \$190,000 pledged for the campaign. Thank you all for your faithfulness. Our commitments were through June, so we are sure we will receive all of the good gifts promised. Our Property team has been receiving new 2019 bids. Good news here, too, the price has not gone up. Although dates are not firm yet, this is generally how we believe the three projects will be scheduled and part of our vendor's bids. The roof will be beginning sometime after Memorial Day and finished before the beginning of VBS, June 17. The parking lot will be completed sometime after July 9 before the end of July. The soffits and eaves will be done last in the month of August.



We are excited that HEART HAS been NAMED the recipient of the Fresh Thyme Giving Bag program. The tag found with this kit is a tag that anyone can print and take to Fresh Thyme and a dollar of their donation will be distributed to HEART though their giving program.
