**Whole Again-** led by Lois Beery in the teacher’s lounge

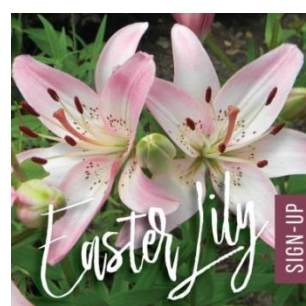
**Children’s Ministry** - Kids gather for worship (meet in the Welcome Center) hearing a Bible story and playing fun games at 6:30pm
