

## COLUMBARIUM NEWS



For those of you who are not familiar with our Columbariums, they are located in our beautiful Memorial Garden adjacent to the walkway to Fritz Hall and the offices.

Our Columbariums provide an opportunity for Messiah members and their families to memorialize their loved ones in a safe and secure resting place. Visitors may enter the the Memorial Garden from an inside door which is never locked.

The Columbariums are constructed using beautiful white Kashmir and black granite. Each Columbarium houses 48 niches and each niche will accommodate two cremains. Cost of a niche is \$ 2,500 payable at time of reservation. The price includes an etched faceplate, the opening and closing of the niche and perpetual care of the Memorial Garden. Funeral services conducted in our sanctuary may be followed by closing ceremonies in the Memorial Garden with inurnment in the Columbarium.
